SAULT STE. MARIE, ONTARIO - Algoma Steel Inc. today announced that the members of United Steelworker (USWA) Locals 2251 and 2724 have ratified recently negotiated collective agreements running to July 31, 2002. These two USWA Locals represent all of Algoma Steel's unionized employees.

He said "These collective agreements will assist the Company's focus on improving productivity and in meeting future financial challenges. The new collective agreements provide for the continuation of cost of living allowances, no increases in wage rates or benefits, and a commitment to a 450 person reduction in employment over the term of the agreements.
